# POSTING AN IMAGE

On screeprinters.net (Different forums have different guidelines)

*In Plain English*



## ■ First and foremost, **THE IMAGE NEEDS TO BE HOSTED BY A SERVER.**

Since there are several ways to accomplish this task, let's go through a few scenarios.

### **USING PHOTOBUCKET** ...or any other online service

[1] Sign up for a (free) account.

[2] Upload your image to PHOTOBUCKET.

[3] **Copy** the image link provided by PHOTOBUCKET and simply **Paste** it into your post.

### **USING Your Own Website** ...without knowing any html code.

[1] Upload your image to your website.

[2] Click on the image and **Copy** the http address that shows in your browser.

[3] When you get to the part in your post that you want to insert an image, first type **[img]**

[4] Then without using any spaces, **Paste** the http address you copied from Step #2.

[5] Lastly, again without spaces, type **[/img]**

## **THAT'S THE SHORT VERSION.**

You can also post links to other websites, make parts of your post bold or underlined, post active links, etc. etc.

If this still sounds confusing or you're hitting a snag somewhere along the way, let's try **POSTING AN IMAGE** in more detail.

# ■ USING PHOTOBUCKET....or any other online service

## [1] Sign into PHOTOBUCKET

Upload Images & Video

Use CTRL to select multiple files

Reduce to: 1024 x 768 (17" screen)

Use our faster [bulk uploader](#) or [old uploader](#)

from:

- my computer
- web URL
- mobile phone
- email
- Ask toolbar

## [2] Select the radio button from **MY COMPUTER**

## [3] Choose Files

## [4] Browse to find the **IMAGE** on your computer. Here's one:



## [5] Upload your image to PHOTOBUCKET.

## [6] PHOTOBUCKET will now list your image like this:

[7] Put a checkmark in the image box.  
and click on the link that says **IMG** code.

A yellow rectangle with the word **COPIED**  
will briefly appear.

This link is now copied to the clipboard on  
your PC.

## **THE HARD PART IS ALL DONE.**

[8] Now it's simply a matter of typing your  
post. Wherever you want that image to  
appear, all you have to do is **PASTE**.

## ■ **USING Your Own Website** ...without knowing any html code.

If you already have a server that you use for your own  
website, you don't need to use a service like **PHOTOBUCKET**.

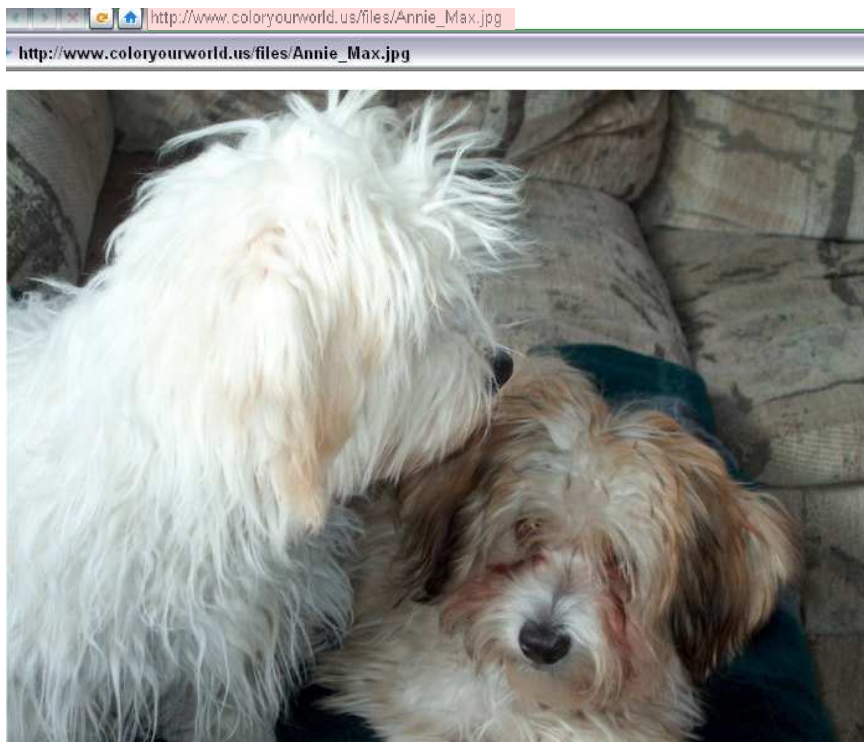
You can upload the image to your server.

This is how I do it, without any html knowledge.

Here's 2 of my Pups:



**[1] I click on the image that I've upload to my site, highlight and copy the http address that appears in my browser.**



**[2] Now when I'm typing my post, I'll use the **IMG** brackets that are listed in the **FAQ** section on the forum.**

**While PHOTOBUCKET does this for you automatically, when you don't use the service, you need to manually add the tags.**

**[3] So..... when I get to the place in my post, that I want to add my Pups, I'll type **[img]** then click **Paste** then add **[/img]****

**It will look like this (NO SPACES)**

**`[img]http://www.coloryourworld.us/files/Annie_Max.jpg[/img]`**

**TIP:** Don't Preview your post. It messes up the code.

**If you make a goof, go back and use the Edit button.**

**Posting url's work the same way, except you use **[url]** **[/url]** tags on either end, instead of **[img]** brackets.**

**Hot links are slightly different.**
